About the Thalian Association

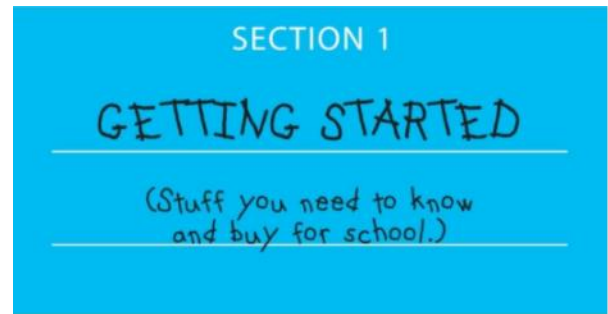

1. Junie B. had 10 rulers and she lost 2 of them. How many rulers does she have now?

Hint: $10 - 2 = ?$

2. Junie B. had 7 pencils and she lost 5 of them. How many pencils does she have now?

Hint: $7 - 5 = ?$

3. Junie B. had 3 sticks of glue and she lost 1 of them. How many sticks of glue does she have now?

Hint: $3 - 1 = ?$

4. Junie B. had 12 sheets of paper and she lost 10 of them. Then she found 7 more sheets of paper. How many sheets of paper does she have now?

Hint: $12 - 10 + 7 = ?$



5. Junie B. had 17 safety scissors and she lost 5 of them. Then she found 3 more safety scissors in her backpack. How many safety scissors does she have now?

Hint: $17 - 5 + 3 = ?$
