About the Thalian Association

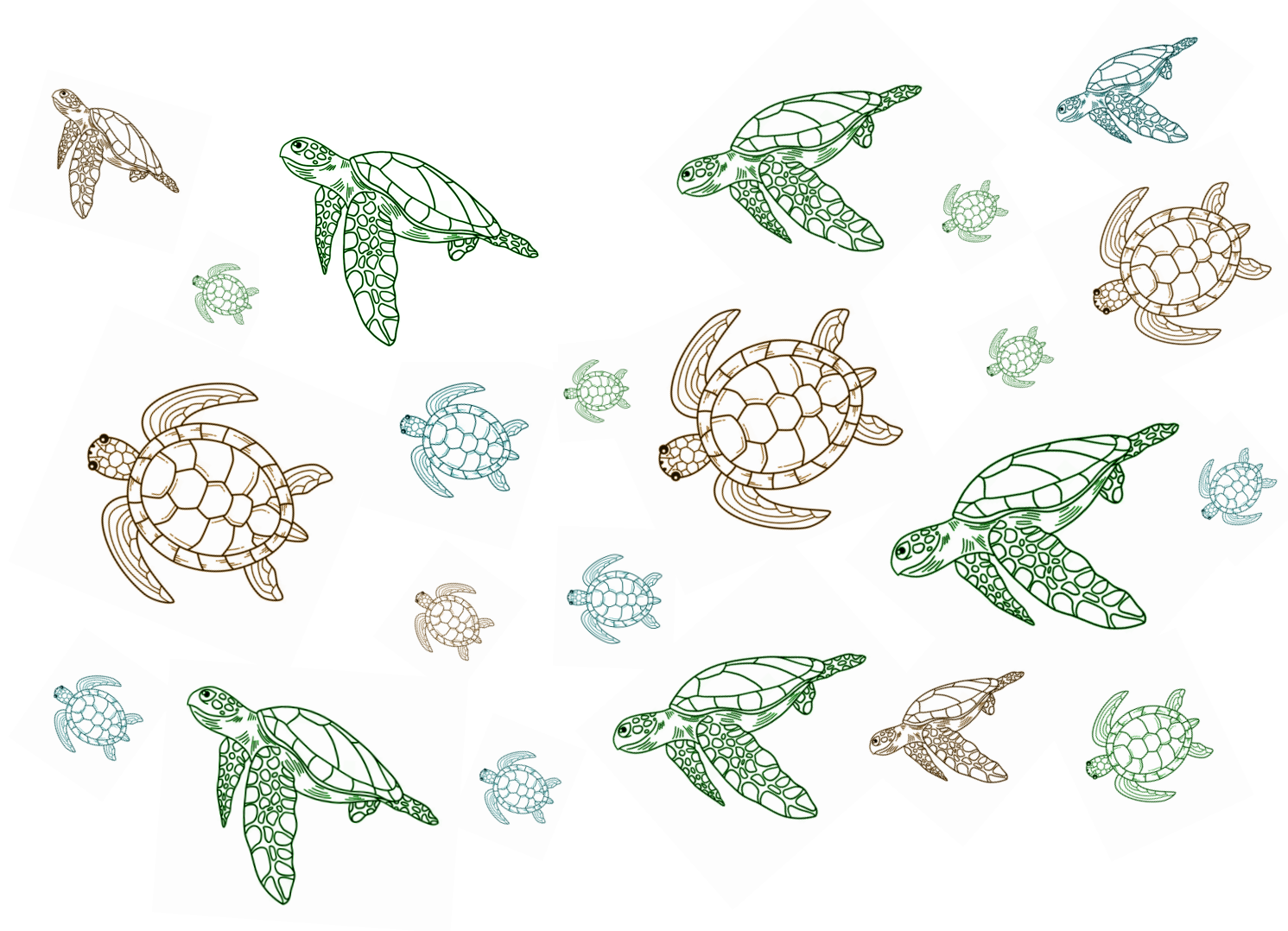
